



Blood donation is a safe practice.

Thank you for coming to donate lifesaving blood.

We are dedicated to protecting the health of our donors and staff by strict adherence to the following:

- Wearing gloves and changing them often.
- Disinfecting all surfaces and equipment that come in contact with donors.
- Temperature screening before donors enter the Blood Donation Center.
- Providing hand sanitizer for use before entering the donation center and throughout the donation process.
- Wearing facemasks in accordance with CDC guidelines. If you do not have a mask, one will be provided for you.
(Donors will be asked to remove their mask briefly for an oral temperature check during their nurse interview. Donors can temporarily remove their mask while consuming post donation refreshments.)
- Practicing social distancing - including donor beds, as well as in the waiting and refreshment areas.
(Exception to social distancing is between nurse and donor during donor interview and during actual phlebotomy and blood collection.)
- Preparing your arm with aseptic solution prior to blood draw.

All Huntington Hospital staff members are temperature and symptom screened daily prior to entry to the campus.

Finally, only eligible and healthy donors are allowed to give blood.
